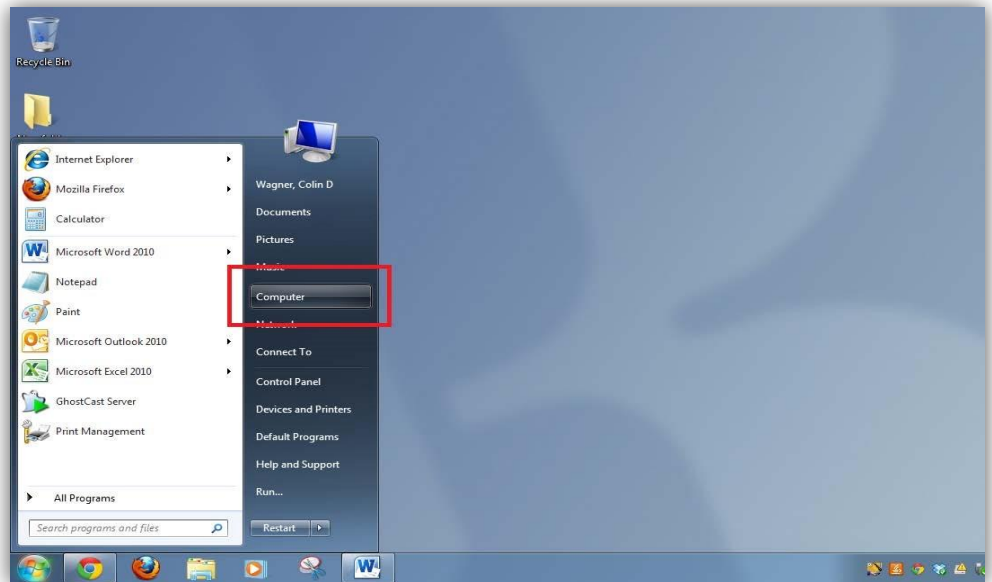




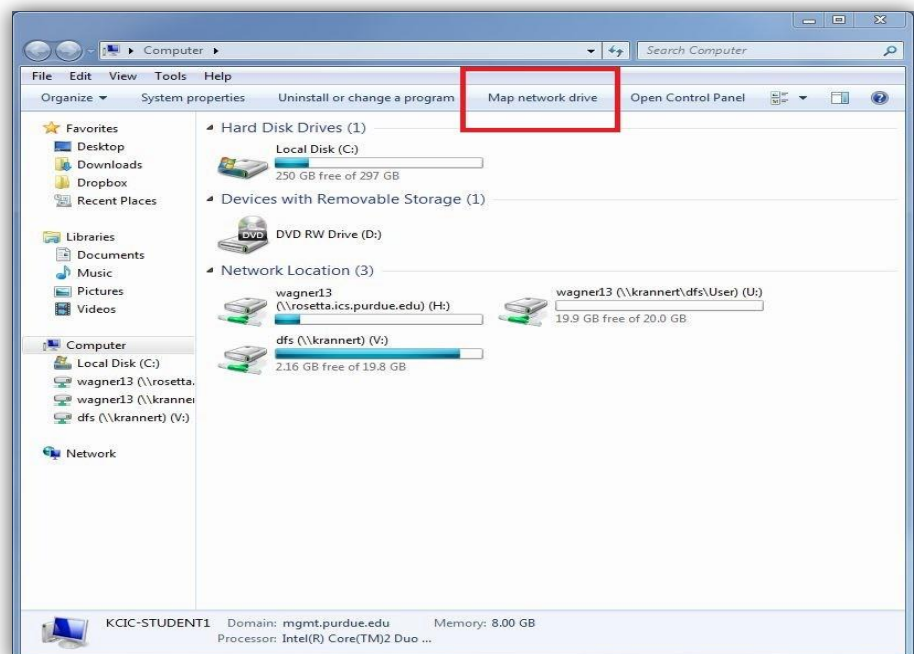
## MAPPING A NETWORK DRIVE AWAY FROM KRANNERT ON WINDOWS 7

This manual lists instructions how to map a network drive when not on the Krannert Domain.

- 1) Press **Start** and click **Computer**



- 2) Near the top of the window, click “Map Network Drive”

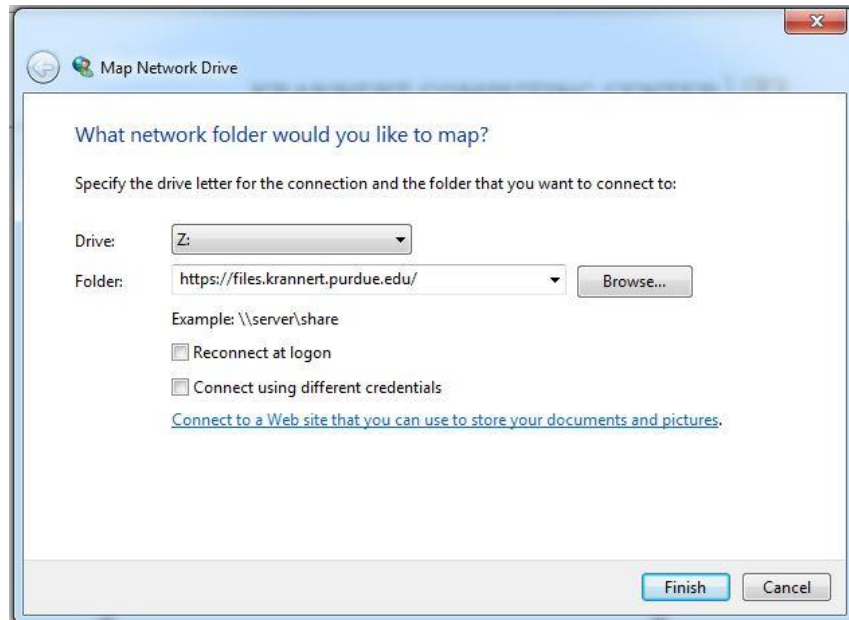




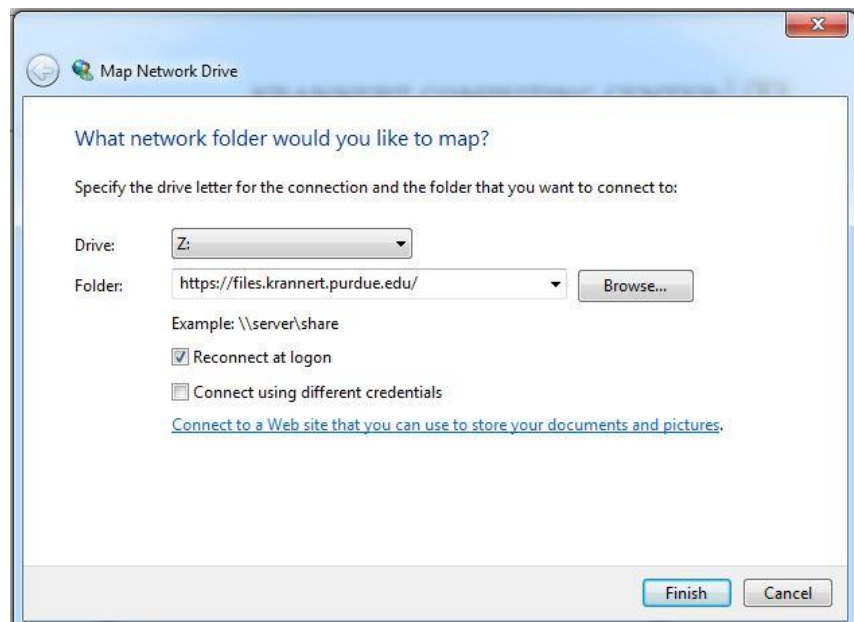
- 3) Select desired Drive letter in the “**Drive:**” drop down box. From there enter path in “**Folder:**”

For V: Drive enter <https://files.krannert.purdue.edu/>

For U: Drive, enter <https://files.krannert.purdue.edu/DFS/USER/username> (where username is you career account ID)

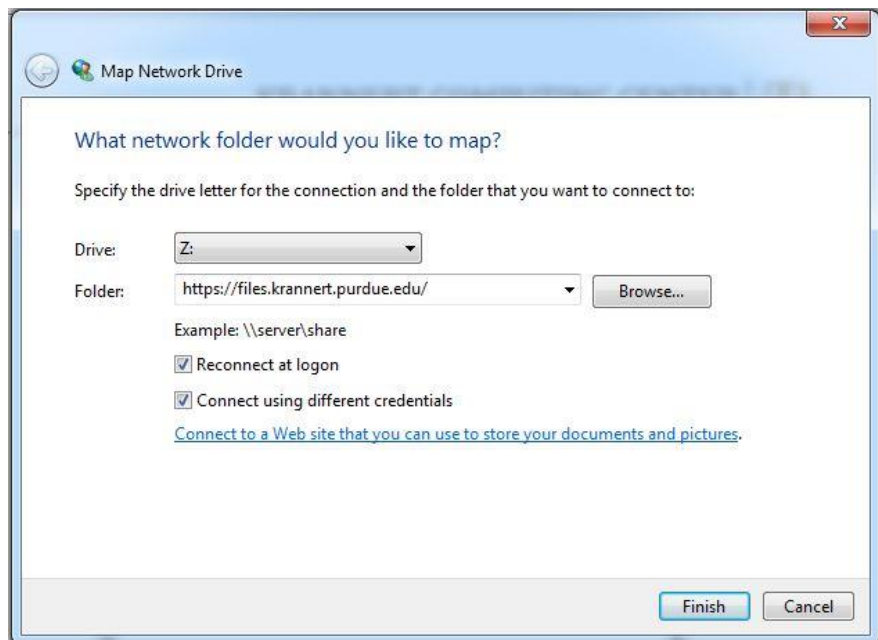


- 4) Click on “Reconnect at login”.

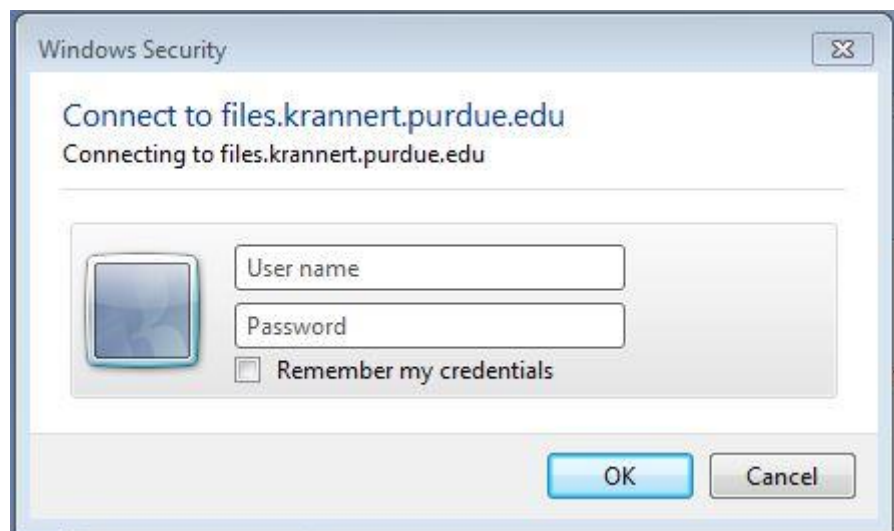




- 5) On Krannert computers away from campus or Krannert laptops just click on **Finish**. All others click on “Connect using different credentials”, *then* click **Finish**.

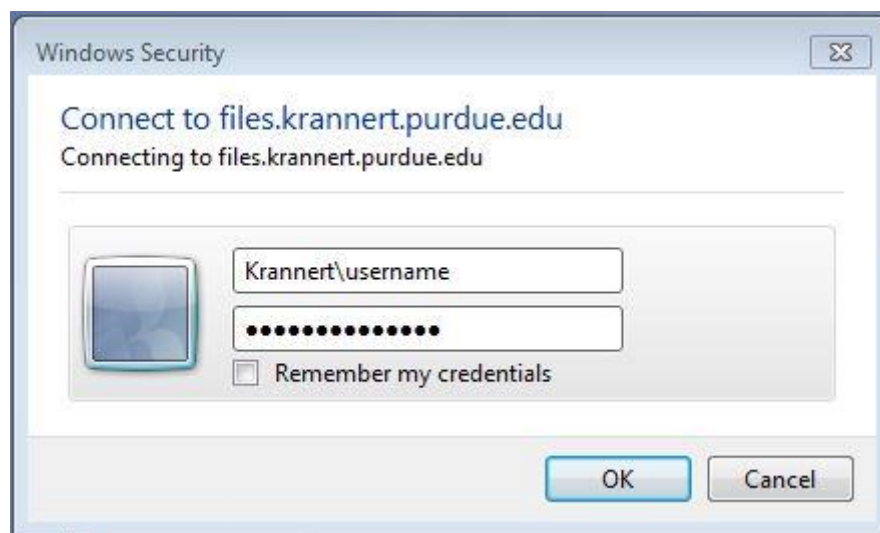


- 6) On Krannert computers away from campus or Krannert laptops, just enter user name and password.

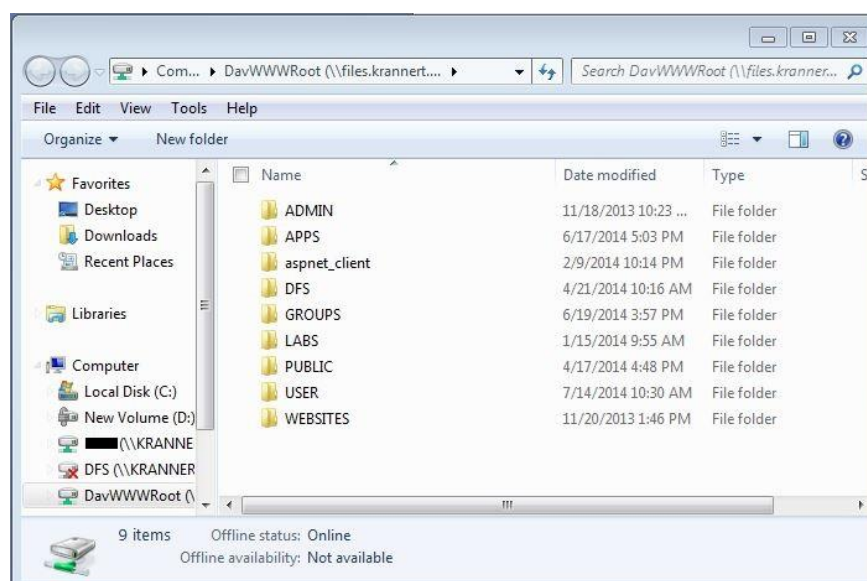




- 7) All other computers, preface user name with "Krannert\".

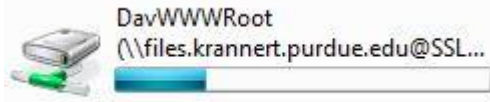


- 8) You have successfully mapped a network drive away from the Krannert Domain.





- 9) The default displayed name is not very descriptive:



You can change the displayed name by right clicking on the drive in the drive list and select rename.
